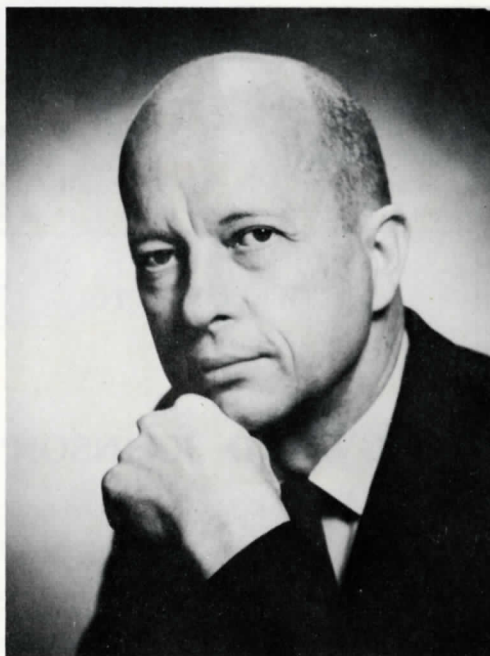
From President of American Motorcycle Association
