WELCOME TO "HOME OF CHAMPIONS" READING FAIRGROUNDS

The "Home of Champions" welcomes you. All the past "greats" in motorcycling racing have been competing here in Reading at one time or another. Among those who have posted wins at Reading is the man whom this Memorial Race is named — Billy Huber. Other outstanding names have included Paul Goldsmith, Bobby Hill, George Roeder, Everett Brashear, the late Bates Molyneaux and the incomparable, Carroll Resweber, the only rider to win the title of Grand National Champion for four consecutive years and who has won the Huber in 1960 and 1961.

Those were yesterday's stars and today we are privileged to have today's stars all ready to vie for the honor known to many as "the little national." Over 30 experts alone are on hand, and among them include the 1967-68 Champion himself—Gary Nixon. You'll recall Gary won the Huber last year and is hoping to make it two in a row.

The "King of half-miles" is also here and the list of Markel wins are almost endless. He's been Grand National Champion in 1962, 1965 and 1966. He also won the Huber in 1964, 1966 and 1967 and to date, has chalked up more wins at Reading than any other rider.

The entry list goes on — Dick Mann who now resides in Richmond, California, has come back to try to chalk up another Reading main. His 1967 Reading National victory will be long remembered and he's here today to get in on the action. Watch the Number 2! Following 2, comes 3 and this year, there's a brand new wearer of the National No. 3, Fred Nix. If you've followed his career, you'd note that Nix nearly won the Grand National Point Race last year, he lost it by nine points to Gary Nixon. He placed second in last year's Reading National, so Freddy definitely has a personal feel for the Reading half and will be doing his utmost to covet today's final.

Probably one of the most famous Brothers Combinations is that by the name of Palmgren. Larry is known to everyone in the east as a real winner, so much so, he chalked up the most half-mile wins that any other rider in the entire country. Larry broke his so-called Reading "jinx" by winning the Pennsylvania Dutch Classic in 1968. His younger brother, Chuck has made quite a name for himself in one year. In his first try on the National Circuit, he ranked ninth in the point standings, and to any racer this is an achievement, Chuck placed second last year in the Huber and you can bet, he'll try to up it to first.

Speaking of brothers, there is still another Brothers combination, this one, a threesome. The Varnes family is one well known, especially here in the east and for the very first time, three brothers by the names of Jim, Ed and Fred will be competing in the expert class racing against one another.

Darrel Dovel is known all over the country, the very likeable and capable #45 is on hand to try to obtain his second major Reading win. His first was winning the Pennsylvania Dutch in 1967. Dovel has been named as the overall flat track high point rider in 1968, a distinctive honor.

Pennsylvania fans can be proud of two very fine riders of the Keystone state. Georgie Longabaugh is an unpredictable here at Reading, but he boasts of two Reading wins, that being the Holiday Classic in 1967 and 1968. The other outstanding Pennsy rider is the likeable Bob Sholly. The #98 is always in there but is still looking for his first Reading victory.

There are many others here today who are all very fine competitors. You pick your favorites and cheer him on, and by the end of today's program, we'll all know the winner of the 16th Annual Billy Huber Memorial.
