An amateur rider is one who by his ability, experience and record of winning events has demonstrated higher than average rating and has been placed in this classification by

the American Motorcycle Association's competition committee.

Expert Riders

An expert rider is one who by his ability, experience and record of winning events has been judged by the competition committee as belonging in this select bracket of competitors.

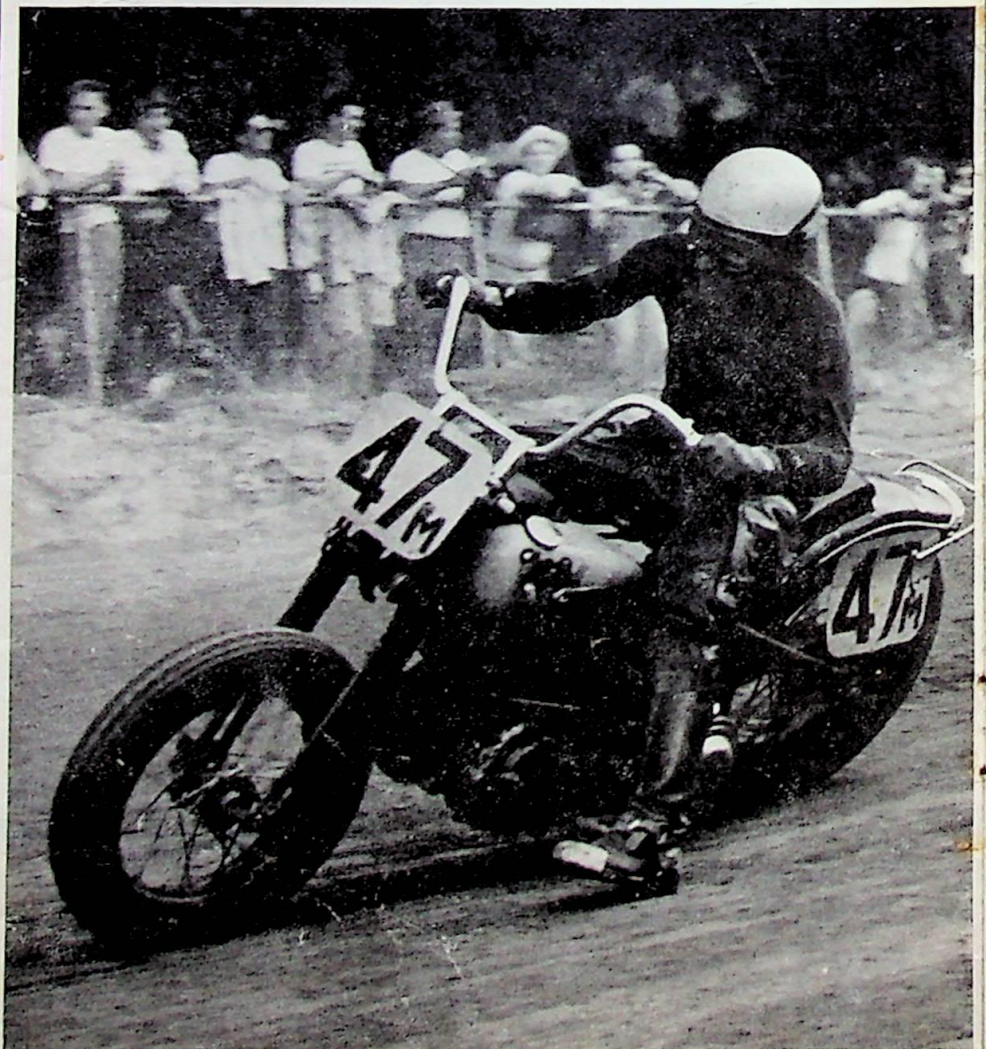

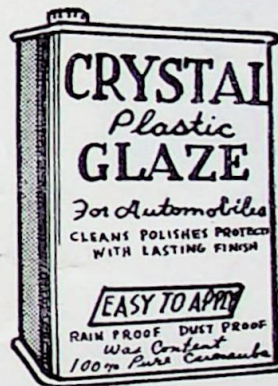

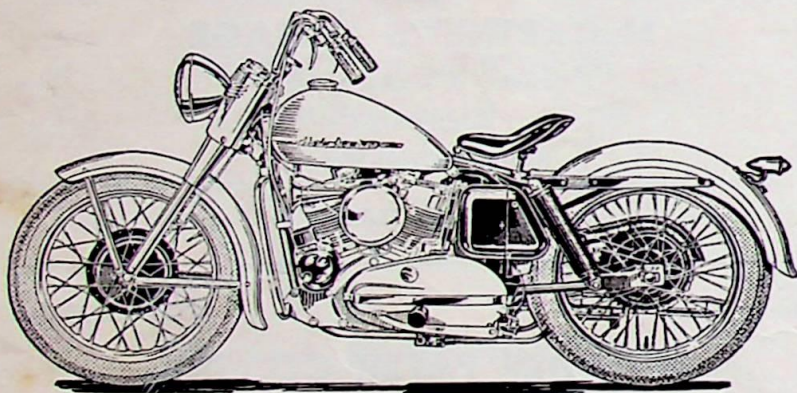

1951 American Motorcycle Association Safety Record

The Peoria Motorcycle Club is a chartered Club of the American Motorcycle Association. A total of 1,182 AMA clubs traveled 259,961,052 miles last year. The accident rate per 100,000 miles was .259, making an average of 386,272 miles per accident.

Stated in another way, AMA clubs last year traveled 10,439 times around the world, making 15 trips around the globe before suffering an accident.
